

SURVEY ON JAFFREY'S SOLID WASTE SITUATION

THE JAFFREY TRANSFER STATION / RECYCLING CENTER STUDY COMMITTEE was appointed by the Selectmen "to study and review the current operation of the Jaffrey Transfer Station / Recycling Center and to provide alternatives to the Selectmen for improvements."

The Committee has designed a **Survey** to help it document the use and operation of the Transfer Station ("dump"), to gain a better understanding of the opinions of Jaffrey citizens regarding the Transfer Station and how it is run and paid for and to determine what changes and improvements might be recommended for consideration by the Selectmen and the voters.

Copies of the Survey are available at the Transfer Station, the Town Offices, the Chamber of Commerce and the Library.

Completed surveys should be returned by **October 1st**. They may be placed in specially marked boxes at the Transfer Station, Town Offices, or left at the Chamber of Commerce office on Main Street.
