



## **Harvard Travellers Club.**

The Harvard Travellers Club was organized in 1902 to promote intelligent travel and exploration, especially by Harvard men. The Club has at present one hundred and twenty-six members, forty-two of whom, having travelled somewhat off the beaten track, are ranked as Fellows.

The management of the Club is under the direction of the Fellows, who govern through an executive committee appointed by them. Membership is not limited to Harvard graduates and undergraduates. Application blanks for membership may be obtained from the Secretary. Members residing in the Boston metropolitan district are charged an admission fee of five dollars. There are at present no annual dues. The regular meetings of the Club, to which members may invite their friends, are usually held in the Harvard Union, Cambridge, on the last Friday of the months from October to May (December excepted). A meeting is occasionally held in a large lecture hall, open to the public, followed by a reception for members and their friends at the Union. Three or four Fellows' meetings are held during the year, for consideration of the business of the Club. A series of "practical talks" on special subjects, related directly or indirectly to travel and exploration, are also given during the year.
