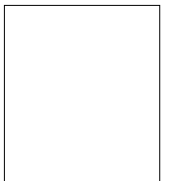

IN CELEBRATION of its centennial year, the Jaffrey Center Village Improvement Society is presenting a multifaceted exhibit in the first floor display cases of the Jaffrey Civic Center. Artifacts, photos, and timelines highlight the history and current activities of the V.I.S., as well as the collections in the Melville Academy Museum. Pieces from the museum, including a sampler, candle molds, and lanterns, illustrate life in early 19th century Jaffrey. Vignettes of Jonas Melville, a student attending the Melville Academy in 1841, and Jonathan Gibbs, shoemaker and involved citizen, offer other insights into local history. The V.I.S. history exhibits were created by Robert Stephenson. Sally Larsen and Mary Jo Marvin, with the invaluable help of Ron Yantis at Inkberry Framing, produced the Melville Academy displays.

The Civic Center is at 40 Main Street next to the Jaffrey Library. Telephone: 532-6527. It is open Tuesday 10-6, Wednesday-Friday 1-5, and Saturday 10-2. Closed Sunday and Monday. The exhibit and reception are free to all.
