ON MONDAY the Fourth of July 2011 at Noon, **The Declaration of Independence** will be read by volunteers, each reading a short section from the stage of Jaffrey's historic 1775 Meetinghouse on Route 124 in Jaffrey Center. Local officials, community leaders and Jaffrey citizens, young and old, have been invited to participate.

Following the reading, there will be an **Ice Cream Social** on the lawn of Melville Academy. The **Little Red Schoolhouse** and **Melville Academy** will be open; and the restored **Seagrave Fire Engine** will be on the Common.
