## JAFFREY HISTORY INDEX

The following is a subject index, unlike the Volume III index which consisted of 17 pages of nothing but surnames. The Jaffrey History Committee hopes you will find this one more useful. We urge readers to use this volume as many families use the Bible, to record important family events such as births, marriages, and deaths. If you want to create an index for your own family you can easily do so. As you read the text and come across the name of a family member, take a moment right then to jot down the name and the page where it appears. Later you will be able to find the reference again quickly. The blank pages in the book are a good place to record this information permanently. Because loose pieces of paper seem to have a life of their own, we don't recommend you use them.

Because the Genealogies are arranged alphabetically by family name, they have not been indexed. To cross-reference one family's connection to another, jot down right on the page what page to turn to to make the connection. You will note that some cross-referencing has already been done for you, but your own personal knowledge may contain other links, so enter that information for future generations.

History does not stop or start at some predetermined or arbitrary point in time. It is an ongoing process that will never stop as long as there are people living on the planet. The Jaffrey History Committee hopes that readers will use this book to record events that have already transpired since our cut-off date in 1998. We also hope they will record what is yet to come.

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
