

My Keys at Rivermead, The Mill and in my Car

There are a number of keys that need to be returned, thrown away or otherwise distributed upon my death or disability.

Three Sections:

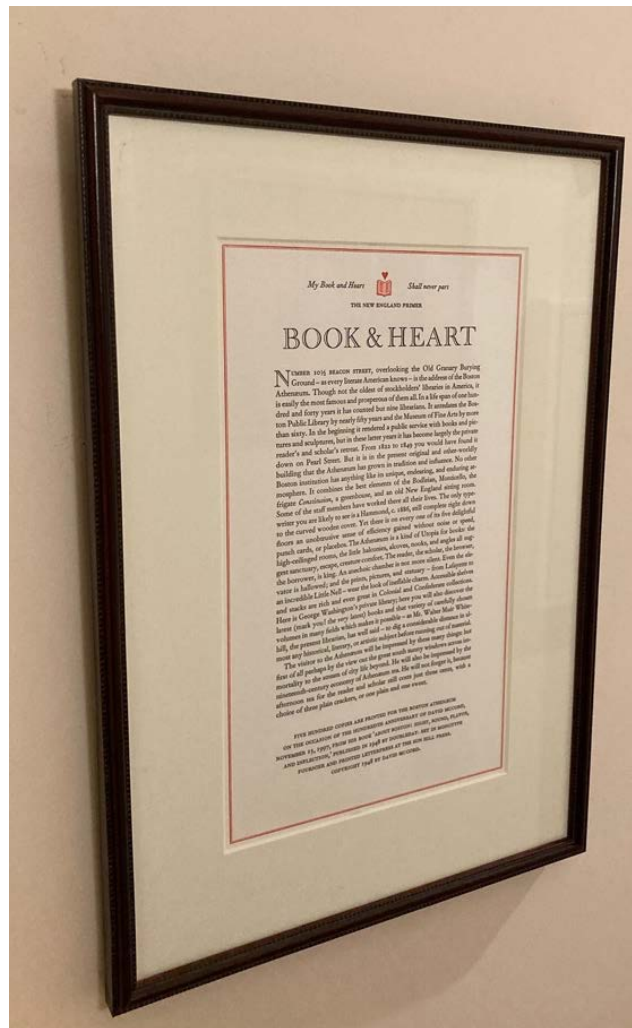
- I. Keys for locks at Rivermead
- II. Keys in or for my car
- III. Keys to or at my Library at 8 main Street, Unit 2

I. KEYS FOR LOCKS AT RIVERMEAD:

- 1)** Key to Apartment 243, Rivermead. To be returned to Rivermead.



- 2) There is a second key to my apartment hanging on the picture hook behind the framed “Book & Heart” to the right of my apartment door. This key should also go back to Rivermead.



Included on key chain:

- a)** Fob to activate locked doors throughout Rivermead.
- b)** Key to apartment (243) door.



- c)** Small brass key to wine cupboard at the Mead (#28).



d) Small silver key for padlock of Storage Unit in basement.



e) ILCO key for postbox 243 in Mead mailroom.



3) There is a locker (#21) at the Fitness Center at The Mead that may have a few things in it. It has a combination lock. The combination is TACOS



4) There are two file cabinets in my apartment each with a key. (The third cabinet, by the Office window, has a lock but no key that can be found. The fourth cabinet, in the Storage Unit in the Basement, has no lock.)

- a)** One with a key taped to the top is in the Closet.
- b)** The other with a key hanging from the top drawer pull is in the Office.



5) There is a wooden cupboard in the hallway in Apt. 243. The key is in the lock. The key should stay with the cupboard wherever it may go.



II. KEYS IN or FOR CAR:

- 1)** Electronic key to my 2021 Toyota Prius Prime Plug-in. Should stay with car.



- 2)** There is a second key in the brown box (Estate Box G) on shelf to right of computer in my Rivermead Office. Should stay with car.



3) In the center console of my Toyota Prius there is a single key to 8 Main Street, Jaffrey, with an "Ireland key fob." (front door only)



4) In the center console of my Toyota Prius there are two keys to 8 Main Street, Jaffrey, with an "EMS key fob." (front & closet doors)



5) Keys to the Jaffrey Meetinghouse. The large key is for the main south doors. (It is actually not needed as the doors push out without the need of a key.) The square brass key is a master (#M-1) and will open all locks (Tower, Balcony, Bulkhead). The other two brass keys are either out-of-date or not known. The silver key is for the Little Red Schoolhouse. These are all to be returned to the Town of Jaffrey (presently Judy Zola) with the exception of the Schoolhouse key which should go to the Jaffrey Historical Society.



6) Three keys that operate the red Club steering wheel lock device that is kept in my Toyota Prius.



7) The key to the Jaffrey Town Office. This should be returned to the Town of Jaffrey (presently Judy Zola).



8) There is a padlock & key in the console of my Prius. This is a so-called “Cat Key,” meaning the key will operate any Cat padlock (used by many municipalities, etc.). It can be kept, thrown out or given to the Jaffrey DPW.



III. KEYS TO or AT MY LIBRARY AT 8 MAIN STREET, UNIT 2:

1) Key to my Library (Unit 2, 8 Main Street, Jaffrey). Alarm will have to be turned off upon entry (1899). The brass key is for the main entrance door; the silver key is for the closet, typically unlocked. These should be given to the Jaffrey Historical Society to which I've bequeathed the real estate. Generally kept in my briefcase, pocket or sometimes in my car.



2) Additional keys to Unit 2, 8 Main Street, Jaffrey, are kept:

- a)** In the (Estate Box G) on shelf to right of computer in my Rivermead Office. For front door only. This should be given to the Jaffrey Historical Society to which I've bequeathed the real estate.



- b)** Hanging on bulletin board to left of computer in Office (closet door). On lanyard with Jaffrey Mills fob.



- c)** Hanging on bulletin board to left of computer in Office (closet door only)



3) There is a safe inside the lower storage cabinet in the closet which operates with a key and by combination (**1899B**). The key is in the lock. The key should remain with the safe wherever it goes.



4) In the closet are two metal storage cabinets. The keys for these are also in the top kitchen drawer. These should remain with the cabinets wherever they go.



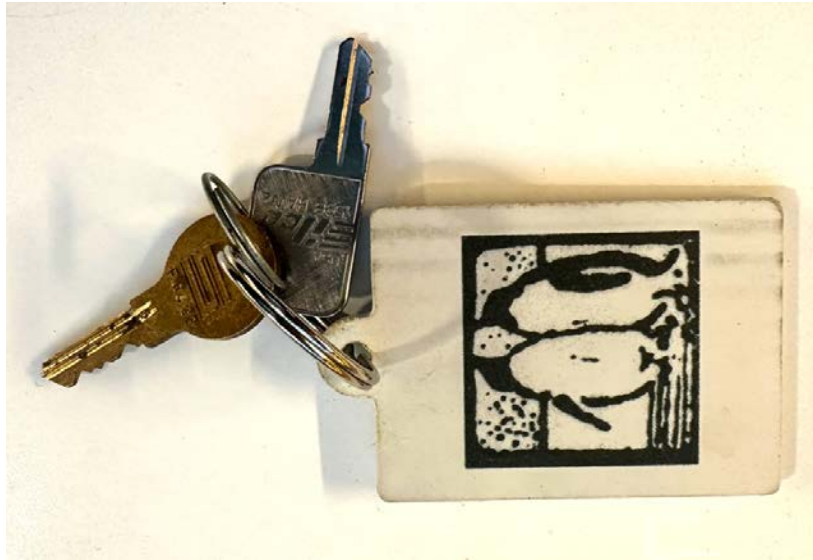
5) The glass-fronted bookcase in the front room has a key which is kept in the lock or the top kitchen drawer. This should remain with the bookcase wherever it goes.



6) Padlock on flower box outside Unit 2, 8 Main Street, Jaffrey. Key yet to be found.



7) Hanging on bulletin board to left of computer in Office. Unknown what this key fits. Could be a key to my old house, 347 Main Street. I seem to recall that I used this key fob for a second key which I probably turned over to the new owner. Can be thrown out.



8) Combination bicycle lock once used to secure teak bench. Combination: **5651**. Kept in top left drawer of case in foyer of Library. As of 8/23/24 used to secure bike in garage at Rivermead. Combination tag (center in photo) now in Estate Box in Office at Rivermead.
