LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT

OF

HARRISON E. KENNARD

I, HARRISON E. KENNARD, of Newton, in the County of Middlesex and Commonwealth of Massachusetts, do make, publish and declare this to be my Last Will and Testament, hereby revoking any and all wills and codicils heretofore made by me.

After the payment of my just debts and funeral and burial expenses and the expenses of administering my estate, I make the following provisions for the disposition of my property.

FIRST: I give, devise and bequeath my real estate comprising approximately sixteen acres of land and the buildings thereon, which are now numbered 246 Dudley Road, in that part of said Newton known as Newton Centre, to the CITY OF NEWTON, on condition that the said City shall accept the whole of the same for the purpose of a permanent park, but if said City shall refuse to accept said entire parcel of real estate for the purpose of a permanent park, then I give, devise and bequeath the same to the METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF MASSACHUSETTS, on condition that the said Commission shall accept the whole of the same for the purpose of a permanent park, but if said Commission shall refuse to accept said entire parcel of real estate for the purpose of a permanent park, then I give, devise and bequeath the same to the BOSTON MUSEUM OF SCIENCE, located at Science Park, Boston, Massachusetts 02114. If either said City of Newton or said Metropolitan District Commission shall acquire said real estate as above provided for the purpose of a permanent park, I direct that said park shall be known as "Kennard Park." If the said Boston Museum of Science shall acquire said real estate as above provided, then without imposing any trust, it is my hope that the said Boston Museum of Science will place conservation restrictions on the entire property as a whole, before ever selling it, so that it may never be divided into smaller lots.

SECOND: I give the sum of four thousand (\$4,000.00) dollars to the BUCKINGHAM BROWNE & NICHOLS SCHOOL, located on Gerry's Landing Road, Cambridge, Massachusetts 02138.

THIRD: I give the sum of two thousand (\$2,000.00) dollars to the MASSACHUSETTS GENERAL HOSPITAL, located on Fruit Street, Boston, Massachusetts 02114.

FOURTH: I give the sum of one thousand (\$1,000.00) dollars to the APPALACHIAN MOUNTAIN CLUB, located at 5 Joy Street, Boston, Massachusetts 02108.

FIFTH: I give the sum of three thousand (\$3,000.00) dollars to HARVARD UNIVERSITY, located at Cambridge, Massachusetts 02138.

SIXTH: I give the sum of one thousand (\$1,000.00) dollars to the HARVARD CLUB OF BOSTON, located at 374 Commonwealth Avenue, Boston, Massachusetts 02215.

SEVENTH: I give the sum of two thousand (\$2,000.00) dollars to the HARVARD TRAVELLERS CLUB of which I was Secretary-Treasurer from 1961 to 1976, this amount to be held intact on a permanent basis, (but not as a part of the "Permanent Fund" so-called,) the income only to be used as current funds.

EIGHTH: I give the sum of five thousand (\$5,000.00) dollars to LYDIA LUND KENNARD, 55 Liberty Hill Road, Bedford, New Hampshire 03102, if she survives me.

NINTH: I give the sum of one thousand (\$1,000.00) dollars to TRINITY CHURCH IN THE CITY OF BOSTON located at Copley Square, 206 Clarendon Street, Boston, Massachusetts 02116.

TENTH: I give the sum of two thousand (\$2,000.00) to Mrs. HENRIETTA LOUISE BRODERICK, 30 Allandale Street, Jamaica Plain, Massachusetts 02130.

ELEVENTH: I give the sum of one thousand (\$1,000.00) dollars to each of the following named persons who survive me:

TWELFTH: I give such of my medical books as it may select, to the FRANCIS A. COUNTWAY LIBRARY OF MEDICINE, Harvard Medical School, 10 Shattuck Street, Roxbury, Massachusetts.

THIRTEENTH: I give my grandfather clock to my niece, HENRIETTA LOUISE BRODERICK, if she survives me.

FOURTEENTH: After the payment of all monetary legacies and all expenses of administration and all estate, legacy, inheritance and succession taxes, and all taxes of like nature payable with respect to any property disposed of by this will or otherwise, I give, and bequeath all my remaining securities and investments, including bank accounts and cash to the BOSTON MUSEUM OF SCIENCE.


FIFTEENTH: All the rest, residue and remainder of my property and estate of whatever nature and wherever situated I give, devise and bequeath in equal shares to LYDIA LUND KENNARD, 55 Liberty Hill Road, Bedford, New Hampshire 03102 and to HENRIETTA LOUISE BRODERICK, 30 Allandale Street, Jamaica Plain, Massachusetts 02130, if they survive me, or all to the survivor of them alone who survives me.

SIXTEENTH: I direct that all estate, legacy, inheritance and succession taxes, and all taxes of like nature, payable with respect to any property disposed of by this Will shall be paid out of the assets specified under Paragraph Fourteenth of this Will and then if necessary out of the residue of my estate charged to the expenses of administration.

SEVENTEENTH: I constitute and appoint the FIDUCIARY TRUST COMPANY, a Massachusetts banking corporation, located at 175 Federal Street, Boston, Massachusetts 02105, to be the Executor of this Will, and I request that it shall not be required to furnish any surety or sureties on any bond given as Executor hereof. I give to my said Executor the full power and authority to sell, convey, and assign any or all of my property and estate, real, personal and mixed, without applying to any court for leave, and I direct that no purchaser or purchasers of any of such property shall be required to see to the application of the purchase money.

EIGHTEENTH: For the purposes of this Will, a person shall not be considered to have survived me if he or she shall die within thirty (30) days of my decease.
