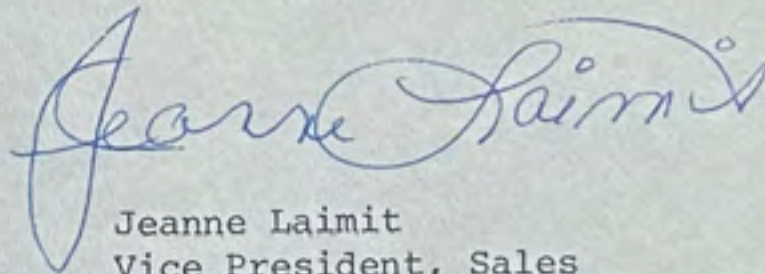
Dear Mr. Stephenson:
