## Town Meeting

Town Meeting in Pratt Auditorium in 2025.




Due to Covid, Town Meeting was held outdoors at Hope Fellowship Church in 2020 & 2021.

## Town Offices

There were no physical Town Offices until 1870 when office space was incorporated into the newly remodeled Meetinghouse.


Town Offices from 1955-1995.


