Dave Chamberlain was going to contact other departments about the use of a ladder truck. I've not heard how that ha gone.

Yellow tape was put up around the Tower entrance. This is fine but how do we handle upcoming events? There could a "downtown" concert there tonight if rain is predicted. The Church Fair is coming up 1-5 August. Driscoll memorial service on 12 August and two concerts soon after. What should the process be re the tape?

Dennis Wright has an 80-foot lift for the next 2 weeks for a job on Gilmore Pond. He might be able to bring it up to the MH and use it to get someone up to the upper bell level to secure the railing, or if necessary, to remove it. There woul be a cost to do this.

We need to address this sooner than later.

Hello,

When Mike Petrovick and I were at the Meetinghouse today at the Contractors' Walk-thru we noticed that the balustra above the bell level of the Tower has shifted further to the east. See photos below. I'm also attaching some photos fro ca. a year ago. The change is evident.

We both felt this should be stabilized in some fashion, tied down or such. At the moment it could pose risks to people below or to the main roof if it were to fall, fully or in part. Mike would prefer that it be stabilized versus removed as it w be more easily replicated during the Tower project.

Access to that level is tricky from within. Perhaps a someone from the DPW could attempt it.

Or a lift or crane could be brought in to access it, or possibly a ladder truck from a fire dept in the region.
