### **Mission Statement:**

The Jaffrey Civic Center is a designated 501(c)3 non-profit cultural facility which first opened its doors in April 1966. It was funded and built by Jaffrey native and teacher, Marion Mack Johnson, a dedicated public servant, who wanted to make sure that all residents in the Monadnock region had access to art and culture. The mission of the Jaffrey Civic Center is “to provide and sustain a public venue where citizens, residents and visitors of the Monadnock region can pursue artistic, educational and civic activities.” The Center’s **goal** is to contribute to the cultural enrichment and enlightenment of the community. There is no admission fee to the Civic Center and all of our art shows and receptions are FREE and open to the public.

I think it is fair to say that going forward our vision is to position the Civic Center as a regional cultural center, which offers art classes, holds diverse cultural events and functions as a destination type of organization which attracts visitors due to the quality of the classes, exhibits, etc.
